Bring them into the kingdom of Your Son. (1 Peter 1:3; Acts 26:17-18; Colossians 1:13) *Continue each prompt with personal prayer....*

- Your promise to hear and heal our land requires that we humble ourselves and pray. Convict us to get on our knees and seek Your face. Show **us** where our hearts have turned away. May we return to You. (2 Chronicles 7:14; Psalm 139:24; Jeremiah 15:19) *Continue each prompt with personal prayer....*
- Fill us with Your Spirit! May we like the early church, devote ourselves to prayer, even corporate prayer. You work wonders as the church prays—breaking chains, knocking down prison doors. Do it again! Ignite a passion within us to pray. (Acts 12:5-7) *Continue each prompt with personal prayer....*
- Help us to always be prepared to give an answer to anyone who asks us for a reason for the hope that is in us. May we speak with gentleness and respect. (1 Peter 3:15) *Continue each prompt with personal prayer....*

**Because You are Adonai, Lord and Master, help our nation’s leaders to submit to You (Colossians 1:16)....**

- May they fear You for that is the foundation of true wisdom. Guide and help them to obey Your commandments so they will grow in wisdom. (Psalm 111:10) *Continue each prompt with personal prayer....*
- We pray they will be humble, not selfish, considering others more significant. Guide them to live in peace with fellow workers. (Philippians 2:3; Romans 12:18) *Continue each prompt with personal prayer....*
- As bills are written, laws are passed, executive orders given, guide them to do what is good and right in Your sight, so that it may go well with them and with our nation.
