RESPONSIBILITIES

- Prays daily for the needs of members, guests, and our church family
- Provides prayer updates to the Director
- Develops an efficient method of collecting and distributing class prayer requests each week
- Ensures that prayer is a key element of each class period
- Contacts and encourages those who have requested prayer
- Enlists members for prayer during the Worship Service when assigned by the Prayer Ministry
- Informs the Divisional Minister of urgent prayer needs that involve the hospitalization of class members

WHY PRAY IN SMALL GROUPS?

- Prayer allows us to enter the presence of God in a personal, relational way
- The primary focus in prayer is our relationship with God
- Small group prayer time helps people grow in their experience of prayer in a safe environment

WHY PRAY IN SMALL GROUPS?

- Prayer can be an intimidating exercise for many people
- Like any form of communication, prayer is learned
- Romans 8:26-27, 26 Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. 27 And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.
