




Wisdom Literature



- Based on PARALLELISM and INTENSIFICATION






Hebrew Poetry

 Antithetical Parallelism – second line is the opposite or in contrast with the first line – second line aims to view the truth from a different angle, intensifying it and driving the truth home

• Example: 10:1

"A wise son makes a glad father, but a foolish son is a sorrow to his mother."
