- The unfolding of your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple. (Psalm 119:130)
 - May Your people in Congress and all State legislatures spread and shed light! May these places be filled with men and women who are wise, understanding, and experienced leaders. Let them do what is right in Your sight. Save any still in darkness. (Matthew 5:16; Deuteronomy 1:13, 6:18; John 12:46) *Continue with personal prayer...*
- Appoint judges and officials...in all the towns... They must judge the people fairly. (Deuteronomy 16:18)

 Help our Justices, judges and officials to judge rightly, with no impartiality. Give us people who walk with You, who obey Your laws and seek You. Grant them understanding. Help them to look beneath the surface so they can judge correctly. (Leviticus 19:15; Psalm 119:1-4, 169; John 7:24) Continue with personal prayer...
- The Lord is my light and my salvation— so why should I be afraid? The Lord is my fortress, protecting me from danger, so why should I tremble? (Psalm 27:1)

Please protect our nation and military! Thank You for those who so honorably serve us. Incline your ear to them and rescue them speedily. Be their rock of refuge, a strong fortress to save them. For Your name's sake, lead and guide them. Keep them from traps. (Psalm 31:2-4) *Continue with personal prayer...*

• "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

So many in our nation are lost—unable to see the light of the knowledge of Your glory in the face of Christ. Send someone to open their eyes so that Your light may shine in their hearts. Rescue them from the kingdom of darkness. (2 Corinthians 4:6; Colossians 1:13) *Continue with personal prayer...*

• For you are the fountain of life, the light by which we see. (Psalm 36:9)

May we who live in Your light be clearheaded, protected by the armor of faith and love. You are our Armor of Light! Show us how to use the gifts we've been given to serve others, as faithful stewards of Your glorious grace. (1 Thessalonians 5:8; Romans 13:12; 1 Peter 4:10; Isaiah 58:10) *Continue with personal prayer...*
