We come before You with hearts thankful for allowing us to be born in this great nation, where we have freedom to worship You, freedom to serve You, freedom to be the men and women You created and desire us to be. (Psalm 29:2; Jeremiah 29:11) Continue with personal prayer...

• Give thanks to the Lord, call on His name.... (1 Chronicles 16 8)

We give You thanks, knowing we can call on Your name and all that it represents—You are LORD, Lord of All, for whom nothing is impossible. You are for us, You are with us, like a mighty warrior at our side. You are everything! (Acts 10:36; Jeremiah 32:17; Matthew 28:20; Jeremiah 20:11) *Continue with personal prayer...*

• Thanks be to God, who always leads us.... (2 Corinthians 2:14)

We are grateful that You picture Yourself as our shepherd, faithful to lead, guide, direct, and provide for us. You lead us in paths of righteousness and assure us that we will never be in want. You watch over us in places of rest and restoration. (Psalm 23) Continue with personal prayer...

• Thanks be to God, He gives us the victory.... (1 Corinthians 15:57)

How grateful we are for the victory You give us over sin, that You are with us to bring us through every temptation. You are transforming us into the image of Your Son, our Savior. May the desire of our hearts be to imitate Him. (1 Corinthians 10:13) *Continue with personal prayer...*

• Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances.... (1 Thessalonians 5:18)

Help us to always be joyful, no matter what we face, because we know You are for us. May we pray without ceasing and stay in constant fellowship with You. Lead us to give thanks in all circumstances because we know You are with us and in control. (Romans 8:31) Continue with personal prayer...
