- Blessed are the peacemakers... (Matthew 5:9)
 - We're grateful that President Trump and leaders of our nation are pursuing peace in the world. Bless them and grant them success. The hearts of all leaders are like channels of water in Your hand. Turn the hearts of leaders of Russia and Ukraine to peace, for the sake of the lives of their citizens. (Psalm 34:14; Proverbs 21:1) Continue with personal prayer....
- "May there be peace within your walls and security within your citadels." (Psalm 122:7)

 We cry out for the peace of Jerusalem and for the hostages to be freed. In Your mercy, help them and their families. May Jewish people be secure in the world, and in our nation. Stop the disease of anti-Semitism. Draw all people in the Middle East to Jesus. (Psalm 122:6; John 6:44) Continue with personal prayer....
- For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus. (1 Timothy 2:5) Oh, that those far from You would hear and understand! Send someone to them with good news that there is peace with God through Jesus, who is Lord of all. May they believe and make Him their Lord and Savior—for He will be their peace. (Acts 10:36; Romans 10:14-15; Ephesians 2:14) Continue with personal prayer....
- Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? (Romans 8:35)

Thank You for the peace this truth gives—that nothing will separate us or our brothers and sisters in Christ from Your love, not even persecution. Comfort and strengthen those being threatened, arrested, abandoned, beaten... Protect and hold them close. (Isaiah 41:10; Psalm 119:76) Continue with personal prayer....

• "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly." (John 10:10)

There are many who live without peace in their lives, facing daily stress that often seems overwhelming. Don't let the enemy push them to contemplate suicide. Help them to call on Your name for You save those who do. Show them Your love. (John 14:1; Romans 10:13; 1 John 4:16) Continue with personal prayer....

- Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and to be holy... (Hebrews 12:14)
 - Guide us to strive for peace. Sometimes we lack peace because of our own reckless thoughts or actions. May we be holy. Help us to confess, apologize and forgive others. Let us do our best to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. (1 Peter 1:16; Matthew 6:12, 14; Ephesians 4:3) *Continue with personal prayer....*
- "I have told you these things so that in me you may have peace. You will have suffering in this world. Be courageous! I have conquered the world." (John 16:33)

We are overwhelmed by the suffering. But we are more overwhelmed by Your glory and grace! Help us to remember that we are conquerors through Christ who loves us. May we have our feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. (Romans 8:37; Ephesians 6:15) Continue with personal prayer....
