

Breaking the Mold: Keeping LifeGroups Fresh & Engaging

- We want to change up what we do each week to keep things fresh and not so predictable.
- Repetition is okay, but if we use the same format week after week things can grow stale.

Prayer

- This should be weekly but the way we do it can change. Whatever you do, spend more time praying than requesting prayer. God said, 'My House shall be a House of Prayer'...not a house of prayer requests.
- In these examples we'll give, keep in mind we never want to embarrass someone who doesn't like to pray out loud.

Prayer Examples

- Pray in small groups of 2-3, remaining in chairs, turned to those nearby. Share requests with one another and have one person pray.
- Have a basket for prayer requests and make a prayer list for the class to use during the week.
- Provide the printed list of the Group's prayer requests and divide into larger groups, standing in prayer circles, praying aloud for as many requests as time allows.
- Praying for the person on your left and then on your right.
- Have someone guide the prayer time, moving from praise, thanksgiving, confession, and intercession.
- Share requests, encourage everyone to pray for a couple requests silently and then have your Prayer Coordinator close in prayer.

Testimonies/Reports

These should be done monthly or seasonally

- Once a month allow a member to share their 'story', especially including their salvation testimony and what Jesus is doing in their life now. Block out 10 minutes for this.
- Invite a Minister, Associate, or Intern to come every so often to share about their family/ministry and then have a special prayer over them.
- Have Shepherd Group Leaders share a 2-3-minute report on their sheep followed by a prayer over their group.

More Ideas

- Conversation Starters Close time in discussion with a couple conversation starters provided by your Teacher, in groups of 2-3 or whatever is easiest depending upon your seating arrangement.
- Birthday/Get Well Cards Members should be receiving these from their LifeGroup, either from the entire Group or their Shepherd Group Leader.
- Missions Emphasis/Projects We want every LifeGroup serving on mission together. Participate in SERVE SATURDAYS but also consider other ways of doing missions together. There are many opportunities...ask your Divisional Minister!
- Scripture Memory Bible Verse for the week
- Announcements Do Share Highlights but please do not just read the announcements. Do send them via email to your LifeGroup members and prospects!
