# Heartbeat of Evangelism

  - Endeavor in prayer (Romans 10:1)
  - A sanctifying experience (Galatians 1:10)
  - Simple obedience (Matthews 28:18-20)
  - Eternally rewarding (1 Thessalonians 2:19)



# The Art of Asking Good Questions

- Make a connection
  - What is your name?
  - Tell me about your family?
  - Where do you work?
  - What do you do in your free time?
    - Look for common ground





# The Art of Asking Good Questions

- Identify a pathway
  - What's your favorite part about your family?
  - Why did you choose to live in DFW?
  - What do you enjoy most about your job?
  - What is one thing that has you excited about life right now?
    - Look for an opening



# Turning the Conversation

- Sympathize with them (Heb 4:14-16)
  - I can imagine that is a difficult situation...
  - I know that has to be hard...
- Tell them about how God has led you through a similar situation
  - Magnify God's grace, be vulnerable about your situation, & celebrate what God has done!

- Can I tell you how you can become a 10?
