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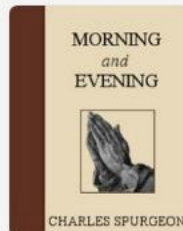

Grace In the OT, the RSV renders *ḥēn* by "grace" on four occasions only (Est. 2:17; Ps. 45:2 [MT 3]; Jer. 31:2; Zec. 4:7), while in two other instances (Zec. 11:7, 10) *nō'am* (cf. Ugar. *n'm*), "grace," "kindness," is used to convey the concept. *Ḥēn* is widely translated as "favor" in the RSV and NEB, where the AV reads "grace." The term carried some breadth of meaning for OT writers, beginning with the ordinary sense of that which brought approval, delight, and joy (Gen. 33:15; 1 S. 16:22) and also describing aesthetic experiences of loveliness and sweetness (Est. 2:9; 5:2). In a more developed form it signified goodwill toward a person, as between God and man (Gen. 6:8), an...
