SCAN ME

EYES WIDE OPEN

Before entering a crisis scenario—whether emotional, relational, spiritual, or circumstantial—pause and recognize the spiritual atmosphere you are entering.



SCAN ME

WISDOM

Before choosing to get involved, recognize:

Crisis is under the influence of the demonic.



SCAN ME

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE GETTING INVOLVED

Have I prayed and listened?



SCAN ME

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE GETTING INVOLVED

Is Jesus inviting me into this and if so, to what extent?



SCAN ME

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE GETTING INVOLVED

Will my presence reflect the nature and character of Christ?



SCAN ME

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE GETTING INVOLVED

Am I emotionally regulated right now, or am I entering from a place of personal distress?



SCAN ME

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE GETTING INVOLVED

What is my motive? Am I trying to fix, rescue, or control?



SCAN ME

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE GETTING INVOLVED

Am I trying to seek justice, or relieve my discomfort?



SCAN ME

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE GETTING INVOLVED

Is my perspective clear or am I projecting past wounds onto this moment?



SCAN ME

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE GETTING INVOLVED

What does obedience look like for me?



SCAN ME

PARTNER WITH AND BE PRESENT

Partner with and be present

What they need:

- Someone who listens but does not languish.
- A calm, confident presence.
- Connection not solutions.



SCAN ME

PARTNER WITH AND BE PRESENT

Confidence

“I only do the works that I see my Father doing... and only say what the Father is telling me to say.”

John 5:19;12:49



SCAN ME

PARTNER WITH AND BE PRESENT

Key phrases:

- “I hear you...”
- “I don’t know, but I understand...”
- “I can’t imagine... tell me.”



SCAN ME

GIVE LANGUAGE

Give language

What they need:

- Their own language for what they are experiencing and feeling.



SCAN ME

GIVE LANGUAGE

Key phrase:

- “What you’re feeling is real. Do you have a word for it?”
- “You have permission to feel whatever you want.”



SCAN ME

REORIENT TO TRUTH

Reorient to truth

What they need:

- Loving truth – not opinions or cliches.



SCAN ME

REORIENT TO TRUTH

Refrain from making judgements about how things will be

- “It’s going to be OK.”
- “You’re (they are) going to be fine.”
- Refrain from spiritualizing traumatic events.



SCAN ME

REORIENT TO TRUTH

How to help:

Listen for agreement with lies and inner vows –

- “This will never get better.”
- “God doesn’t care.”
- “It’s all my fault.”



SCAN ME

REORIENT TO TRUTH

Key phrases:

- “I hear you, but who told you that?”
- “What has Jesus told you?”



SCAN ME

RETURN TO IDENTITY

Return to identity

What they need:

- A reminder of who they are – not just what they are going through.



SCAN ME

RETURN TO IDENTITY

How to help:

They may not have the capacity to reconnect to their God-given identity. You are to model it for them.



SCAN ME

RETURN TO IDENTITY

Key phrases:

- “Who does God say you are – even in this?”



SCAN ME

OFFER NEXT STEPS

Offer next steps:

What they need:

- Questions – not answers.



SCAN ME

OFFER NEXT STEPS

How to help:

Don't push for a resolution.



SCAN ME

OFFER NEXT STEPS

Steward don't own.

This is not YOUR crisis, as an outsider you may not agree with some of their choices – let them choose anyway without judgement.
