- Purpose? To inform and involve women in PBC Women's Ministry
- Prerequisites? Be involved in the WM and in a LifeGroup!
 - **Reach**-Encourage women to invite friends/coworkers to WM bible studies & events
 - **Learn**-Check in regularly to prestonwoodwomen.org and share what's there with your LG
 - **Love**-Help women connect to ministry activities that promote spiritual development and community
 - **Multiply**-Create new bible studies within your LGs that can potentially result in multiplication to neighbors, family, coworkers, friends, etc....



***WHY** do we do this?*

Because Scripture commands it.

“Therefore, be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.”
Ephesians 5:1-2 (ESV)

Romans 16 contains a list of women who **WORKED** for the building up of the early church! Phoebe, Prisca, Aquilla, Mary, and Rufus’ mom—all of them “working, caretaking, serving, caretaking”—exactly what we should be doing in the present day.

GOAL: We should be striving for increasingly deeper discipleship and service among the women in our church, both in community and in our individual spheres of influence, in joyful obedience to Christ and His Word.
