Multiply to Reach

- **Multiply** – *verb*

to increase in number especially greatly: augment

to become greater in number: spread

- **Reach** – *verb*

to stretch out : extend

to make a stretch with or as if with one's hand

to strain after something

Multiply to Reach

- **A LifeGroup win -**

- *LifeGroups reach people for Christ (**Reach**)*
- *LifeGroups disciple people to live like Christ (Learn)*
- *LifeGroups love people like Christ (Love)*
- *Leaders duplicate themselves (**Multiply**) so that they can start new groups (**Reach**)*

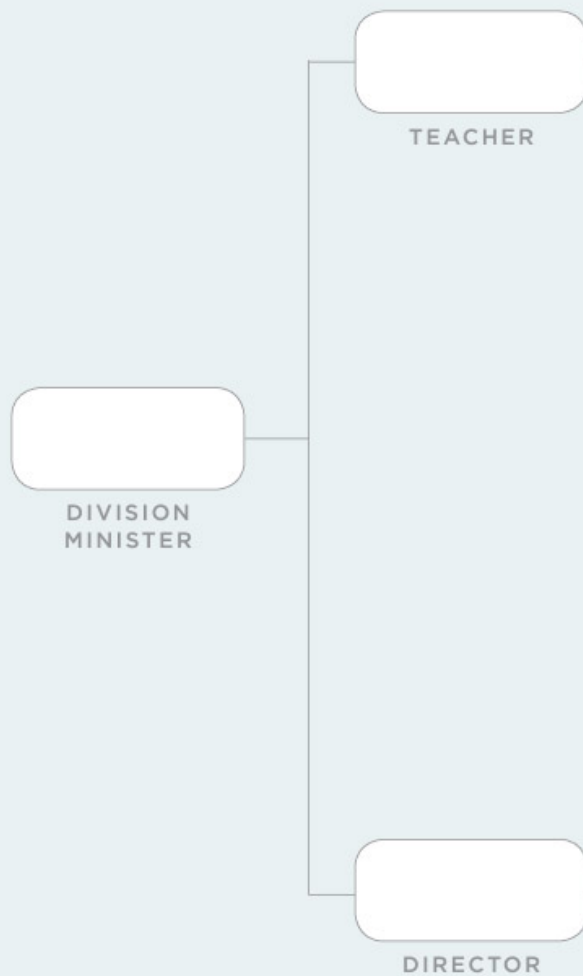

Multiply to Reach

- **Multiplication is all about reproduction**; if that is not happening, we are missing the mark. When we multiply what God has done in our lives from person to person, one generation to the next, we will see a movement of life change as new people are reached and impacted by the Gospel. **Without multiplication, there is no movement, and stagnation forms.**

For LifeGroups to grow and multiply,

- *Leaders must become disciple-makers and, when partnered with the Holy Spirit, multiply their faith and leadership into the lives of others.*
- *LifeGroup leaders regularly pray for and develop new apprentice leaders, expanding the ability of the LifeGroup to minister effectively.*
- *LifeGroups should set an objective toward group multiplication, creating even more opportunities for reaching new people for Christ.*



Multiply to Reach

Reach —

- *Incorporate time in group meetings to share general prayer requests and devote another time specifically to the Guests that have visited recently (Prospect Coordinator).*
- *Have individuals share their testimony at least every other week. This could include how they were introduced to Christ (Member Coordinator).*
- *Plan specific group socials at least every other month, providing a venue for people to invite everyone (Social Coordinator).*



Multiply to Reach

Reach —

- *Plan service projects or coordinate ways the group can serve neighborhoods, communities (Missions Liaison).*
- *Identify ways and highlight examples of group members who are actively moving people through the process, & share testimonies of success at least once each month (Director).*
- *Create a schedule of testimonies from group members and share stories of people moving through the REACH process.*
- *Create a list of all the names from giving out LifeGroup cards in Worship or other places inviting them to your LifeGroup (Prospect Coordinator).*



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LifeGroup(s) and leadership **multiplication** creates more opportunities to welcome guests, disciple believers, and **reach** people with the gospel.

Multiply to Reach

- LifeGroup leaders are successful if he or she is facilitating authentic community and spiritual growth in their group. Specifically, a leader should ask:
 - *Am I becoming more like Jesus? In other words, am I applying what I am encouraging others to apply?*
 - *Am I multiplying myself into other leaders?*
 - *Are members prioritizing our LifeGroups in their schedules?*
 - *Are members experiencing accountability, a sense of belonging and love?*
 - *Are members' priorities becoming more aligned with Scripture?*
 - *Are the members sharing Christ and pointing others to Christ?*
 - *Are members finding ways to use their spiritual gifts?*
